completeness. Root word = integer.

2. God invites people of integrity into \_\_\_\_\_ with him. Psalm 15

*Lord, who may abide in Thy tent? Who may dwell in Thy holy hill? He who walks with integrity, and works righteousness, and speaks truth in his heart. v. 1-2 NAS*

3. We need the \_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus to make us whole, entire and complete.
